
# HOW TRAVEL MAY LOOK IN THE FUTURE TRAVEL SAFETY ALERT LEVELS



## Description

"A COVID-19 epidemic is in general circulation"

"COVID-19 is present in the UK, but the number of cases and transmission is low"

"COVID-19 is not known to be present in the UK"

## Likely Rules

Domestic Travel (including Commo Travel Area) Essential personal movement only

International inbound travel International travellers to quarantin 14 days

Domestic Travel (including Commo Travel Area) Social distancing (2 metres) and

limited capacity on transport International inbound travel International travellers to guaranti

International travellers to quarantin for 14 days

#### Domestic Travel (including Commo Travel Area)

Social distancing (1+ metre) and transport partially reopened in urbo areas

International travellers to quarantin for 14 days; exemptions to EU coun

Domestic Travel (including Commo Travel Area)

Social distancing (1+ metre)

#### International inbound travel

International travellers to quarantin for 14 days; exemptions to EU coun and air bridge agreements with key trading partners providing they car show evidence of containment

#### Domestic Travel (including Commo Travel Area)

No restrictions on travel

#### International inbound travel

International travellers to quarantin for 14 days; exemptions to EU coun and any other nation providing the can show evidence of containmer

## Likely Exemptions

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### Likely Guidance

Stay at home, other than for essential personal movement and doing essential work

Stay in immediate household

Avoid public transport if possible

Walk, cycle or drive

Wear face coverings

Strongly advised to download NHS contact tracing app

Stay at home, other than for essential personal movement and stay within extended bubble

Keep 1+ metre apart outside home where possible and in a controlled environment such as a workplace, 1+ metre distancing is required

Do not use mass transport if required to self-isolate/quarantine, experiencing symptoms, high risk or awaiting a results

Appropriate physical distancing and other risk mitigating measures in place on public transport and aircraft as agreed by relevant agencies

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
